(BI) Barrier Islands Little League 2020 Bylaws

Dated: 2/12/2020 (Revised Date 6/13/2020)

- 1. All games will end at 8:00 pm on weeknights. Friday and Saturday games will be played until games are over.
- 2. Following Age Divisions with played at BI:
 - Baseball Tee Ball 4 7 (10 Players)
 - Baseball Coach Pitch 5 & 6 (10 Players)
 - Baseball Coach Pitch 7 & 8 (13 Players)
 - Baseball Majors 9 -12 (13 Players)
 - Baseball Seniors 13 -16 (14 Players)
 - Softball Coach Pitch 5 & 6 (10 Players)
 - Softball Majors 9 12 (13 Players)
 - Softball Seniors 13 16 (14 Players)
- 3. Draft Method to be Serpentine Method
- 4. BI will have a player pool for teams that are short players. This will be based on a rotation method and Player Agent will need at least 2 hours notice prior to game time.
- 5. BI will have a continuous batting order for regular season play.
- 6. BI will have a 10 run rule and use a 5 run rule per inning until the last inning.
- 7. All Stars Players will be voted on by players, coaches, umpires, board of directors.

- 8. All Stars Coaches will be ranked using a point system using PCA principles, BI rules, and involvement in the league. Points will be tabulated by the Coaching Coordinator and Player Agent. Once coaches are chosen they will be approved by the President and presented to the board for final approval.
- 9. All field rules are followed by signs posted at Maybank Fields.
- Pitch Counts to be lowered from Little League standards to allow for better safety of our players and all more kids the opportunity to pitch.
- 11. Little League Rules No On Deck Circle for Majors and below and they must be in the dugout prior to batting.
- 12. No Intentional Walk
- 13. Helmet Wire Face Mask Rule
 - All Barrier Islands Little League players will be required to wear a wire facemask attached to their helmet.
 - Wire facemasks must come from the helmet manufacturer.
 - This rule is for ages 12 and below.
 - Wire facemasks must be worn at all practices and games on Little League Fields. This includes Maybank Fields, First Baptist Field, and Charleston Collegiate Field. This also includes all cages when hitting.
 - This will include all All Stars games hosted on BI fields and any other fields that are played on during the All-Stars Tournament.
 - This rule will apply to the Islanders Ball Club. All players on Islanders are made up of Barrier Islands Little League players.
 - EXCEPTION: Islander Ball Club players will have the option to not wear wired facemasks during USSSA sanctioned tournaments not played on Barrier Islands Little League fields.
 - Any team that is invited by Islanders Ball Club to scrimmage must also have wired facemasks to play on Barrier Islands Little League fields.
